

Rosedale Sportsmen's 2011 In-House Skeet League

The Rosedale Sportsmen's in-house skeet league will start the week of October 3rd and run thru the week of December 19, 2011. Any member that would like to shoot is welcome. You can shoot your 50 targets on Monday, Wednesday or Thursday from 6pm-10pm. This will be an informal league and shot on the honor system, so please turn in your correct score.

How much will it cost? It will be the cost of your targets, six dollars, plus an additional two dollars a week for the kitty. The club does NOT get any of this money.

What's the two dollar kitty for? In previous years each individual received a small gift at an informal dinner.

Who will collect the money? Targets will be paid for with your coins just like we do now. The two dollars will be collected by individuals to be named at the September 26th opening meeting/ shoot. We need volunteers for score sheet collectors so step up it's your club.

Do I have to shoot with only people in the league? NO, you can shoot with anybody you choose. The only thing that is asked from you is to use a score sheet with your full name and date on it. DO NOT include the NON in-house league shooters.

Ok, I just shot my 50 targets. What do I do with the score sheet? Simply give the score sheet and your two dollars to the person in charge that night. These people will be named at the September 26th shoot and meeting. We will try to have at least one person each night to do this.

What if I miss a week? It is understandable that you may not be able to shoot every week. We all work or have other family issues that take precedence over our shooting. Even though you do not shoot you will still be required to pay your two dollar kitty fee. Once again every shooter will receive a gift at the end of the year and the club does NOT get any of this money.

If I miss a shoot can I make it up? YES, if you miss a shoot you can make it up the following week only. On the score sheet put the current date and SHOOTING BACK at the top.

To qualify for a shooting average at the end of the year and have your name placed on the Rosedale IN-House League Plaque you must have at least ten out of the twelve shoots.

If at any point you decide to drop out of the in-house league your kitty monies will not be refunded. Remember that you can pay your two dollars every week and never shoot at a target and still receive a gift at the end of the year dinner.

It is our intension to have all the scores posted weekly on our web site. It will have your first name and last initial followed buy your score. We would also like your email so we can keep you informed.
